



The NAESP Legislative Action Center allows NAESP members to contact their representatives in Congress and locate and contact their local media outlets. It also provides information on major legislative and political developments concerning education laws and policies.

To use NAESP's Legislative Action Center:

1. Visit NAESP's Advocacy website (www.naesp.org/advocacy) and click on the button labeled "Legislative Action Center."
2. Log in to the website using your e-mail address and password. You will be taken to the Legislative Action Center's homepage. Your representatives in Congress will be listed on the right hand of the screen, and pertinent political issues currently being debated in Congress will be listed at the bottom of the page.
3. Contact a representative(s) by clicking the "Contact" link next to the representative's picture. You can also click one of the "Take Action" links listed next to the individual issues listed at the bottom of the page and choose which representative(s) you would like to contact regarding that particular issue. Before you submit your message, please carefully read the instructions provided.
4. Information concerning major legislative and political developments can be found under the "Advocacy Information" and "Resources" tabs.
5. The "Contact the Media" tab allows you to locate and contact local media outlets. Please carefully read the provided instructions before submitting a message.
