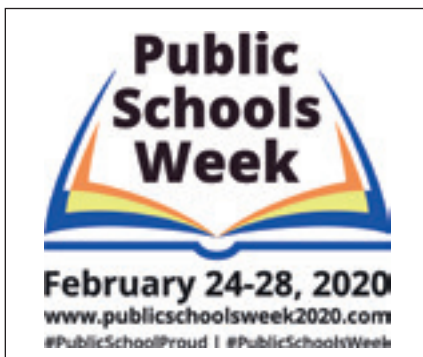
1 Principal pipelines.
